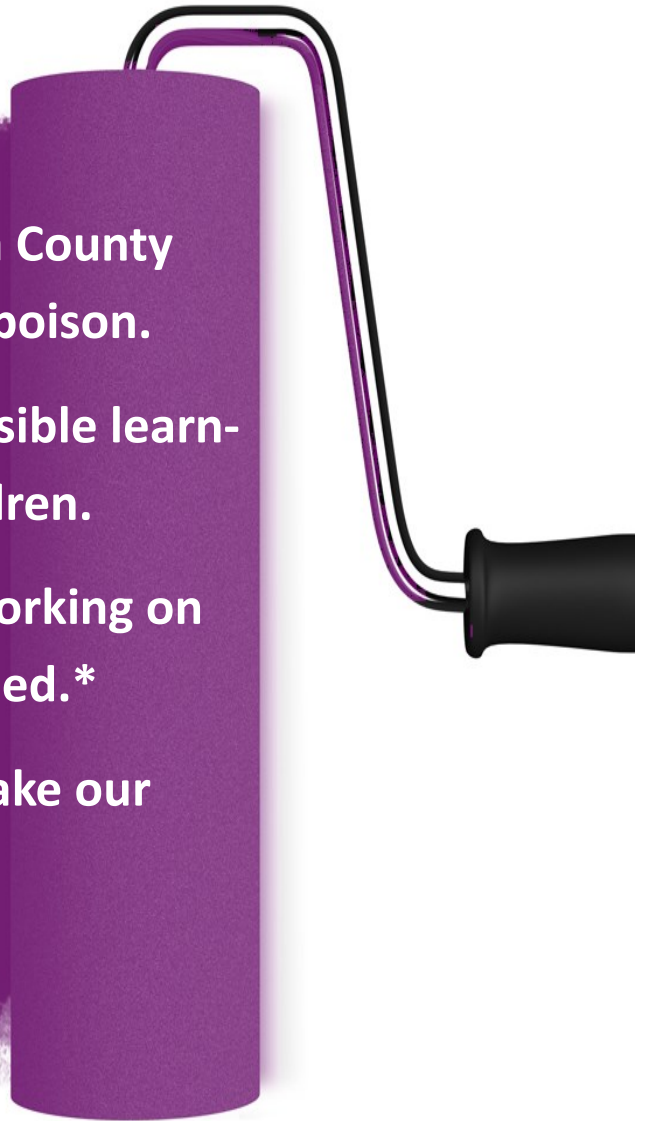


Protect yourself, your family and our kids from the dangers of LEAD PAINT!

**Federal law requires that contractors, landlords or their employees who perform any home improvement that disturbs more than 6 square feet of interior or 20 square feet of exterior lead based paint in rentals that were built before 1978, MUST be certified to do the work safely.*
